



## **Cooperation Agreement between**

## Huaiyin Normal University, China and National Technical University of Ukraine «Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute»

Party A: HUAIYIN NORMAL UNIVERSITY, a university established and existing under the laws of China, and having its principal place of business at 111 West Changjiang Road, Huaian, Jiangsu, P.R. China 223300;

And

Party B: NATIONAL TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY OF UKRAINE «IGOR SIKORSKY KYIV POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE», a university established and existing under the laws of Ukraine, and having its principal place of business at 37 Peremogy av., 03056, Kyiv, Ukraine 03056.

To extend students' international horizon and explore innovative training models, Party A and Party B reach the following agreement after friendly consultation:

- The two parties agree to accept teachers and students based on their capabilities and needs to each other's universities in the field of Biotechnology and Life Science and to recognize the internships to each other's students after the internship completed.
- 2. Both parties agree to accept 1-2 exchange internships from each other's universities each year. Each exchange internship includes up to 20 students and up to 3 teachers for up to 2-4 weeks' internship. It is possible to send more students/teachers with the agreement of the other party.
- 3. About the fees: The tuition, registration fees, board and lodging expenses and transportation expenses involved in the course of the exchange shall be borne by the visiting party itself.

- 4. The internship is conducted in English, so exchange teachers and students shall have solid English proficiency.
- Either party shall provide relative certificates and transcripts to the exchange students and teachers at the end of every exchange.
- 6. Both Parties agree to cooperate in the field of Research, Development and Innovation.
- 7. Both Parties agree to hire the other party's faculty as visiting professor.
- 8. Party B agrees to start PhD joint supervising program with Party A.
- 9. Exchange teachers and students of one party shall follow the regulations of the other party.
- 10. To carry out the processes indicated in paragraphs № 1, 2, 6, 7, 8 of this Agreement, both parties will draw up by an additional contract, which specifies the exact terms, the number of person, the terms of payment and other conditions for their conduct.
- 11. The term of the agreement is THREE years from 1 September, 2018 to 31 August, 2021.
- 12. This agreement is established in duplicate with each party holding one copy.
